



<Marquee> Tag - Notes

The tag is an old HTML element used to make text or images scroll automatically across a webpage. It can move content left, right, up, or down. However, it is deprecated in HTML5 and is not recommended for modern websites. CSS animations are preferred today.

1. Basic Example:

```
<marquee>Welcome to Our Website</marquee>
```

2. Direction Attribute:

```
<marquee direction="right">Move Right</marquee>  
<marquee direction="left">Move Left</marquee>  
<marquee direction="up">Move Up</marquee>  
<marquee direction="down">Move Down</marquee>
```

3. Behavior Attribute:

```
<marquee behavior="scroll">Scrolling Text</marquee>  
<marquee behavior="slide">Slide Once</marquee>  
<marquee behavior="alternate">Bouncing Text</marquee>
```

4. Speed Control:

```
<marquee scrollamount="10">Fast Text</marquee>  
<marquee scrollamount="2">Slow Text</marquee>
```
